 Please bring your entries to the church hall from 9 a.m. onwards. Please park in the Community Hall Car Park. If you need assistance to carry exhibits to the hall please ask a Steward. Judging begins at 11.00 a.m. so exhibitors must have left the church hall by that time. Please ensure that you have completed the details above before you arrive. One entry form per person (regardless of number of classes entered). You may make only one entry in each class. The entry stewards will assign you an exhibitor number and give you sticky labels bearing that number. These need to be stuck to the underside of each exhibit. Items without an exhibitor number will not be judged. You are responsible for displaying your entries, though there will be stewards to help. The judge's decision is final. Entries to be made by donation (minimum 30p per class). Proceeds to the church. The show will be open to the public from around 12.45 p.m. Produce will be auctioned at approximately 3.30 p.m. unless section notes indicate otherwise. You may remove exhibits between 2.15 and 3.00 p.m. if you do not wish them to be auctioned. Presentations for cup winners will take place at the time of the auction. Merit cards for the first three places in each class will be available for collection at the back of the church after the conclusion of the show. 									
Even if you are an experienced exhibitor we strongly recommend that you carefully read both the Schedule AND the Notes for Exhibitors (available from the back of St. Bartholomew's church or from <code>tardprodshow@gmail.com</code>), so that you are sure exactly what is being asked for. Every year, sadly, we have a number of exhibits which cannot be judged because they are incorrect - wrong number of items, unsterilized jam jars etc so if in doubt, ask!
